1. *Dublin City Council is the data controller*
2. *The DPO's (Data Protection Officer) details are dataprotection@dublincity.ie and 01 2223775*
3. *The data subject's rights are:*
 - *The right to access the personal data that we hold about you, together with other information about our processing of the personal data.*
 - *The right to require us to rectify any inaccuracies in your personal data.*

 - *The information is requested in accordance with the Control of Horses Bye Laws 2014 made under the Control of Horses Act 1996.*
 - *It may be necessary from time to time to pass you contact information on to trusted third parties in order to assist with the processing of your application, such as our statutory partners, e.g. An Garda Síochána, as long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential.*
 - *The information supplied by you will be kept securely for a period of up to seven years.*
 - *If the personal data is not given, a Horse licence cannot be issued as it is a requirement under the Control of Horses Bye Laws 2014 made under the Control of Horses Act 1996.*
