Archival History The Wide Streets Commission's records were transferred to Dublin

City Council in 1851 and were placed in the Royal Exchange, which had just been purchased to serve as Dublin's City Hall. In 1954, Dublin City Council transferred most of the Commission's archives, including the map collection, on long-term loan to the Public Record Office of Ireland. Returned to Dublin's City Hall in 1982 and placed in custody of Dublin City Archives. Stored at Dublin Civic Museum, 1995-2002; transferred to Dublin City Library & Archive, 2003.

#### **Content & Structure**

Scope & Content Manuscript maps documenting every aspect of the Wide Streets

Commission's work (1758-1851) including acquisition of property; development plans; and layout of new streets. Geographically, most maps relate to the area between the Grand and Royal Canals. Maps relating to lands purchased by Wide Streets Commission from Dublin City Assembly includes property in county Dublin.
