

## Paper Waste Exports to India

The National TFS Office (NTFSO) wrote to stakeholders on 2 November 2021 advising that shipments of *Paper, paperboard and paper product wastes* in accordance with waste shipment Basel code B3020 to India were prohibited until further notice. This was due to an amendment contained within Regulation (EU) 2021/1840 which updated Regulation (EC) No 1418/2007. Regulation (EC) No 1418/2007 contains an up-to-date list of the waste shipment controls for 'green-list waste' that apply to non-OECD countries for shipments from the EU.

On 31 March 2022, Commission Regulation (EU) 2022/520 was published<sup>1</sup> and it contains an update to the entry for B3020 waste to India which means such shipments are no longer prohibited from the EU. This change came into effect on 1 April 2022.
