**SMITHFIELD HORSE FAIR CASUAL TRADING LICENCE
FEE
BYE LAWS 2013**

The Lord Mayor and members of Dublin City Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of the powers vested in them by the Casual Trading Act, 1995 and all other enabling statutory powers hereby make the following bye-laws to fix a fee in respect of a licence for the casual trading of horses for persons who wish to bring a horse or horses to the Smithfield Horse Fair.

The Council is empowered by Section 6 of the Casual Trading Act 1995 to make these bye laws in respect of the Smithfield Horse Fair being an event to which the public are admitted and at which casual trading takes place.

The Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it hereby makes the following bye laws to fix a fee for a Casual Trading Licence for the casual trading of horses at Smithfield Horse Fair.

Part 1

DEFINITIONS

In the preamble and bye laws themselves the following words shall have the following meanings:

“horse” means a horse, pony, ass, hinny or a mule;

“Casual Trading Licence” means a licence for the casual trading of horses granted under Section 4 of the Casual Trading Act 1995;

Part 2

Bye Laws:-

1. These bye laws shall be cited as the Smithfield Horse Fair Casual Trading Licence Fee Bye-Laws 2013.
2. These bye-laws shall come into operation on the 15th day of February 2013.
3. The fee fixed for a Casual Trading Licence for a person who wishes to attend Smithfield Horse Fair with a horse or horses at the Smithfield Horse Fair is € 10 per horse.
4. A separate Casual Trading Licence shall be required in respect of each horse fair held at Smithfield.
