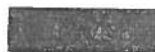

Section 115 of the Road Traffic Act, 1961 – No. 24 of 1961 – provides that any person applying for a learner permit or driving licence shall not furnish false or misleading information in connection with such application. Any person contravening this requirement is liable to prosecution and penalties.

A recognised driving licence is a driving licence issued in a member state of the European Union or of the European Economic Area, or a State declared to be a "recognised State" under the Road Traffic (Recognition of Foreign Driving Licences) Order.

All recognised licences presented for exchange purposes must either be current, **OR-**

(a) in the case of licences issued by a member state of the European Union or the European Economic Area, have expired within the ten year period preceding the date of licence exchange application,

OR

(b) in the case of licences issued by a "recognised State" other than a member state of the European Union or of the European Economic Area, have expired within the twelve month period preceding the date of licence exchange application.
