Applicant Requirements:

Applicants are evaluated on (3) criteria:

- 1.) **Need** - must be on the Dublin City Council Housing, Transfer, or Affordable Housing List
- 2.) Ability to **re-pay a small, low interest mortgage** which Habitat will support you in applying for. (Permanent employment preferred)
- 3.) **Willingness to partner** with Habitat and contribute "sweat equity" volunteer hours into the home. No construction experience is required as all training will be provided on site by professionals.*

*Depending on applicant circumstances non-construction project involvement can be arranged.
