Dublin City Council is inviting the public to comment on its **Your City, Your Space; Draft Dublin City Public Realm Strategy** and on its **Outdoor Advertising Strategy**.

Public Consultation on Your City, Your Space; Draft Dublin City Public Realm Strategy has been prepared by Dublin City Council to detail the importance, character and current issues affecting Dublin's public realm, and develop an agreed vision and policy on the design, standards of maintenance and appropriate uses of public realm. Your City, Your Space; Draft Dublin City Public Realm Strategy has been prepared in accordance with the Planning and Development (Strategic Environmental Assessment) Regulations 2004 and Article 6 of the Habitats Directive 92/43/EEC.

Public Consultation on the Outdoor Advertising Strategy

This strategy is part of the Dublin City Development Plan 2011-2017. The Plan came into effect in December 2011. Dublin City Council now seeks the views of the public on the Outdoor Advertising Strategy which sets out its policy on the location and type of outdoor advertising structures across the City. Depending on the issues raised in submissions received, the City Council will then decide whether a Statutory Variation of the City Development Plan 2011-2017 is required.
