The criteria listed are the assessment criteria the panel will use when considering your application. Your application will be assessed by members of the Arts Service team. Any applications that clearly fall outside the eligibility guidelines and criteria may be eliminated at this point.

Award Criteria for assessment

- CV, covering letter and referees (all received before deadline)
- Experience of painting, carpentry, art handling, condition checking, problem solving, cabling, wiring, attention to detail and finish
- Awareness of health and safety legislation
- Organisational capacity of applicants
- Quality of plans for evaluation and follow up
