# QUALITY BUS CORRIDOR & INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT

## LOWER KILMACUD ROAD – DRUMMARTIN ROAD



## INTRODUCTION

Dun Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in conjunction with the Quality Bus Network Project Office, has prepared proposals to install a Quality Bus Corridor (QBC) and upgrade the road infrastructure on Lower Kilmacud Road and Drummartin Road. The proposals are now on public display and feedback is invited from interested parties.

## WHERE IS THIS HAPPENING?

Lower Kilmacud Road and Drummartin Road.

## WHY IS THIS BEING DONE?

The Quality Bus Network Project Office is working with all Dublin local authorities to build a city-wide network of high quality transportation corridors.

This proposed scheme forms one section of this network, which will eventually connect Sandyford, LUAS, DART, the Stillorgan QBC and Dundrum, providing an attractive public transport alternative that is accessible to everyone.

There are also numerous underground services along the route that are old and need to be replaced such as leaking watermains. These upgrades will be undertaken simultaneously with the QBC works.

## WHAT DOES THE SCHEME INVOLVE?

The scheme involves the provision of bus and cycle lanes along various sections of the scheme, road and footpath reconstruction, carriageway widening, upgraded and new traffic lights, a new traffic management system, traffic calming measures, landscaping and upgrades to sewers, watermains and public lighting where required.

When complete, it will provide a safer environment for pedestrians, cyclists and other vulnerable road users. Buses will benefit from faster and more consistent travel times. General traffic will benefit also with the installation of a new traffic management system.
