The above declaration must be provided by a person who is resident in Ireland and who wishes to exchange a recognised driving licence for an Irish driving licence. A recognised driving licence is a driving licence issued in a member state of the European Union or of the European Economic Area, or a State declared to be a "recognised state" under the Road Traffic (Licensing of Drivers) Regulations, 1999.

All recognised licences presented for exchange purposes must be either current, **OR** -

(a) In the case of licences issued by a member state of the European Union or the European Economic Area, have expired within the ten-year period preceding the date of licence exchange application,

OR

(b) In the case of licences issued by a "recognised state" other than a member state of the EU or EEA, have expired within the twelve-month period preceding the date of licence exchange application.

"Certified Details" must also accompany any licence that has expired from appropriate issuing authority.
