Loop Systems

Dublin City Council has fixed and portable loop systems at our public counters to aid our customers that are hard of hearing. If you enter a Dublin City Council building and you find that the loop system is not switched on, or you would like to conduct your business at a booth that has a loop system in place, please notify a member of staff, and they will arrange this for you.

Public counters which did not have loop systems have been recently installed with them, these include:
