



NOTICE OF PROPOSED ADDITIONS/ AMENDMENTS TO THE RECORD OF PROTECTED STRUCTURES IN THE DUBLIN CITY DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2016 – 2022

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Sections 54 and 55 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 that Dublin City Council proposes the following additions/ amendments to the Record of Protected Structures in the Dublin City Development Plan 2016-2022, in respect of the following structures:

Proposed Additions to the Record of Protected Structures

1. 48 Hardwicke Street, Dublin 1
2. 58 Blessington Street, Dublin 7, Exterior elevations only, excluding modern fascia, shop window & door to front elevation
3. 76 Gardiner Street Upper (former convent) including chapel to rear, Dublin 1
4. 55 Amiens Street, Dublin 1
5. Fumbally Exchange, 5 Dame Lane, Dublin 2
6. Structures 1 (red brick L-shaped wing), 3 (block to S of chapel), 4 (college chapel), 7 (walls of enclosed orchard to S of college buildings and stone shed outside SE corner of garden wall), 8 (enclosed garden to north) & 11 (N stone boundary wall along Bloomfield Avenue) St Mary's College, Gayfield, Bloomfield Avenue, Donnybrook, Dublin 4 (Site is also known as 'Avila')

Proposed Amendments to the Record of Protected Structures

Marlborough Street, Dublin 1, 'Training College (Department of Education) and gate lodge' to amend description to read 'Department of Education comprising former Teacher Training College; Tyrone House; associated gate lodges; former Model School & Scoil Chaoimhín.' New listing will provide protection to Tyrone House, both gate lodges, former Model School & Scoil Chaoimhín.

The particulars of the proposed additions/amendments to the Record of Protected Structures will be available for inspection at the Planning & Property Development Department, Civic Offices, Wood Quay, Dublin 8 from Monday to Friday, (excluding public holidays), between the hours of 9.00 to 16.30 from **Monday, 19th June, 2017 to Monday 31st July, 2017** inclusive. Submissions or observations in regard to the proposed additions/amendments to the Record of Protected Structures may be lodged in **writing** within the above said period to **The Conservation Office, Planning & Property Development Department, Block 3, Floor 3, Civic Offices, Wood Quay, Dublin 8** or made via **email** to **conservation@dublincity.ie** and will be taken into consideration before the making of the additions/amendments.
