Preparation of Local Area Plan for Ballymun

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 20 of the Planning and Development Acts, 2000 (as amended) that Dublin City Council, being the Planning Authority for Dublin City, intends to prepare a Draft Local Area Plan for Ballymun, Dublin 9.

The City Council will also carry out an assessment of the likely significant effects on the environment of implementing the Local Area Plan in accordance with the Planning and Development (Strategic Environmental Assessment) Regulations 2004 and the Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010.

The City Council invites interested parties or individuals to make submissions / observations with respect to the issues for the proposed Draft Local Area Plan during the pre-draft public consultation stage. An Issues Paper has been prepared to assist the making of submissions or observations on the planning issues that the Draft Plan should address.
