

**I HAVE A BANNED DOG, IS
THERE ANY WAY I CAN KEEP IT?
YES, PROVIDED -**

- You are a tenant of Dublin City Council, and
- your tenancy commenced prior to 1st July 2007, and
- you have in your possession a restricted breed dog as described in the attached leaflet.

You will be allowed to retain possession of that dog, provided you comply fully with the requirements set out below.

- Your dog is microchipped
- Your dog is neutered / spayed
- Your dog is licensed
- Your dog is kept under effectual control
- Your dog is muzzled and kept on a lead in a public place

See details in this leaflet of a **Free Neutering and Microchipping** offer from DOGS TRUST open to all Dublin City tenants. This scheme is available to all breeds of dogs and will allow you to retain your dog.

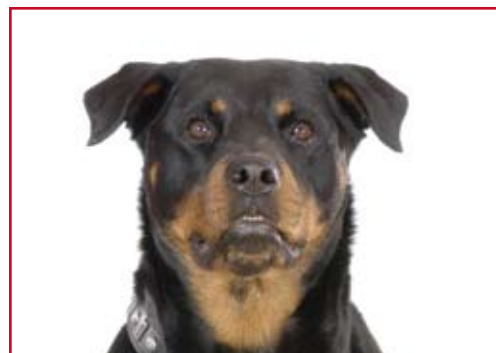
