



PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT OF A NEW CIVIC PLAZA AT COLLEGE GREEN DUBLIN AND ANCILLARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT MEASURES

NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT AND FURTHER SIGNIFICANT INFORMATION TO AN BORD PLEANÁLA

AN BORD PLEANÁLA REFERENCE (29S.JA0039)

Dublin City Council, as requested by An Bord Pleanála, hereby gives notice that on 20th October 2017 Dublin City Council submitted an:

- Environmental Impact Assessment Report (E.I.A.R),
- Significant information concerning proposed traffic management measures, and
- Other significant information regarding the proposed development, such as responses to submissions and observations received by An Bord Pleanála from prescribed bodies and other persons.

This E.I.A.R and further information which has been submitted to An Bord Pleanála, may be inspected free of charge or purchased at a cost not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy during public opening hours from **Friday 19th January 2018 to Wednesday 21st February 2018** (which is a period not shorter than 30 days) at the following locations:

- **Dublin City Council, Planning and Property Development Department, Civic Offices, Wood Quay, Dublin 8 (opening hours Monday to Friday, 09.00hrs to 16.30hrs);**
- **An Bord Pleanála, 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1 (opening hours Monday to Friday, 09.15hrs to 17.30hrs).**

Submissions or observations on these documents/information with regard to the implications of the proposed development for proper planning and sustainable development, and the likely effects on the environment of the proposed development, if carried out, may be made in writing to **An Bord Pleanála at 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1 on or before 17.30hrs on Wednesday 21st February 2018.**

The main elements of the proposed development include:

- The development of a plaza at College Green and Foster Place
- Ancillary traffic management measures on the surrounding road network.

Submissions or observations may be made free of charge by persons who have already made submissions or observations on this application to An Bord Pleanála. Submissions or observations on the E.I.A.R and further significant information made by persons who have not already made submissions or observations on this application to An Bord Pleanála must be accompanied by a fee of €50 (except for certain prescribed bodies).

This Notice is reissued pursuant to the timeframes prescribed in Article 6(7) of Directive 2011/92/EU as amended by EU Directive 2014/52/EU on the effect of certain public and private projects on the environment (EIA Directive) and requiring a timeframe of not less than 30 days be given for consulting the public on an environmental impact assessment report.

Any person who has already made a submission/observation on these documents need not repeat such submissions/observations already made as their submission/observation will be taken into account.

An Bord Pleanála may, in respect of this application for approval-

- approve the proposed development,
 - make such modifications to the proposed development as it specifies in the approval and approve the proposed development as so modified,
 - approve, in part only, the proposed development (with or without specified modifications), or
 - refuse to approve the proposed development,
- and may attach to an approval such conditions as it considers appropriate.

A person may question the validity of a decision of An Bord Pleanála by way of an application for judicial review under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No. 15 of 1986) in accordance with section 50 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended. An Bord Pleanála will be holding an oral hearing into the proposed development, the date of which will be notified in due course.
