Applicant: Dublin City Council

Location: Ballygall Parade / Glasanaon Road, Finglas,
Dublin 11.

Proposal: Pursuant to the requirements of the above, notice is hereby given of the construction of an average 1.7m deep, plan area 4950m² flood storage swale in the Ballygall green area. The swale itself will be split into two halves having approximately the same plan area. This split swale will store floodwaters and thus reduce the risk of flooding in the Ballygall catchment.

The construction processes involved are the excavation of existing soil to the required levels, removal off-site of excavated materials, associated pipeworks, and final re-instatement / landscaping.

Plans and Particulars of the proposed development may be inspected or purchased at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy for a period of 6 weeks from **Thursday 9th May 2013** during public opening hours at the offices of **Dublin City Council, Public Counter, Planning Department, Block 4, Ground Floor, Civic Offices, Wood Quay, Dublin 8, Monday - Friday 09.00 hrs to 16.30 hrs**.
