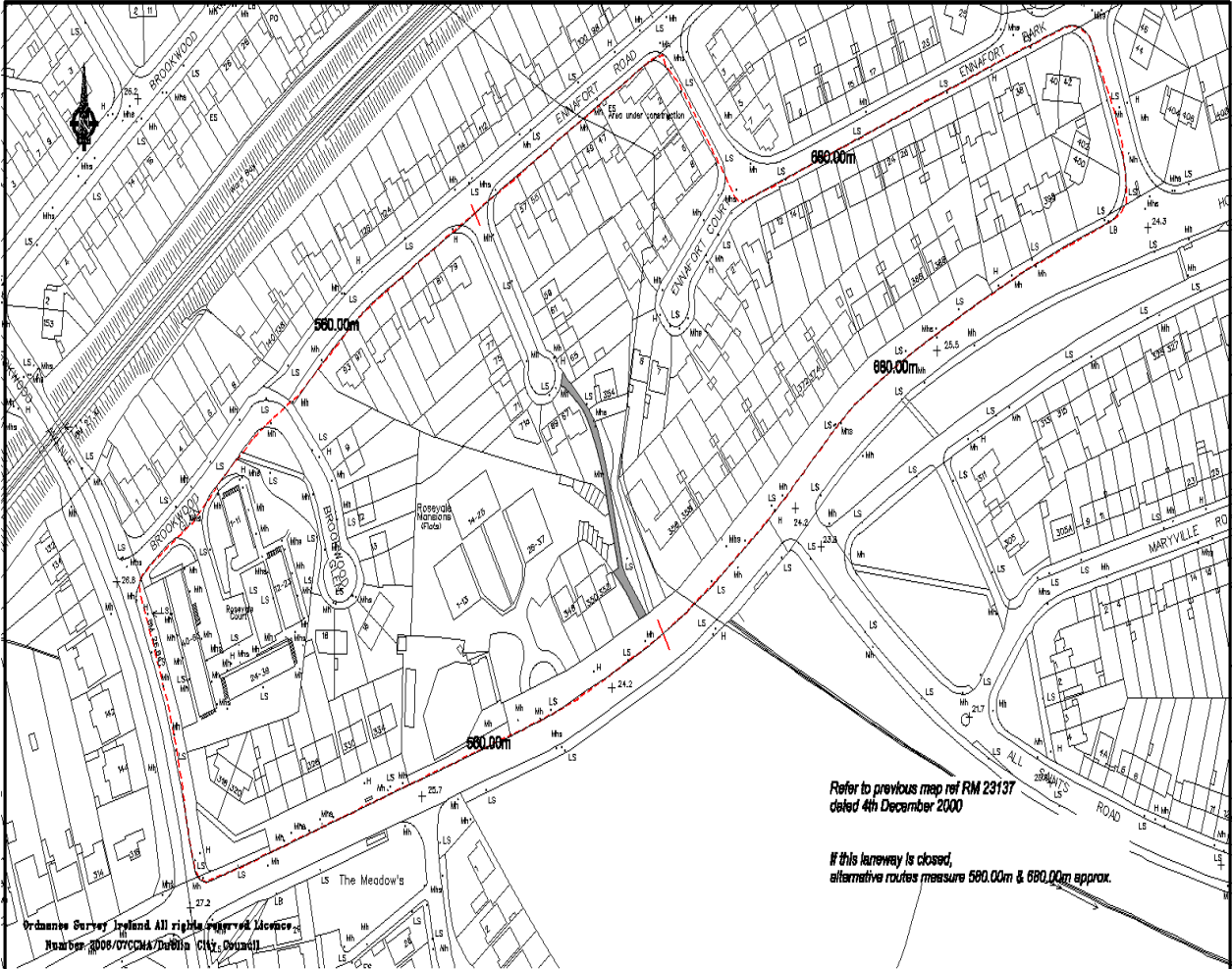
Drainage Division **objects** to the extinguishment as there are 3 local sewers, a trunk foul sewer and a culverted river in the area.
