Clarification on the implementation of the Hydraulic Survey of the Naniken river

No provision was made in the 2013 budgets to carry out a hydraulic survey for the Naniken River. There is no funding in place to carry out the survey.

- **Report back on capacity of attenuation Tank**
The Tank has a capacity of 190 cubic metres and is designed to become operational once road flooding at Maryfield Crecent occurs. The operation of the tank is monitored in times of heavy rainfall
- **Report on Clonshaugh Treatment Plant and possible effects on the Naniken river**
The proposed wastewater treatment plant lies outside of the catchment of the Naniken River and consequently has no effect on it.
- **Report on effect of Port Tunnel on Naniken river**
The Naniken River is siphoned under the Port Tunnel adjacent to the northern portal of the Port Tunnel at Santry. The siphon, maintained by operator for the Port Tunnel, is sealed and there is no evidence of any leakage from the siphon or into the siphon.

Re: Report to Area committee on Operation Leaf Fall in North Central Area.

The North Central Area Office alongside Waste Management Services and Parks Division is improving the leaf fall collection service for the coming Autumn/Winter season 2013. This will allow the Council to target priority areas and to maximise the voluntary effort from residential communities who assist the Council in leaf collection. This voluntary effort will be supported by Waste Management who clear and collect heavy tonnages in areas like Griffith Avenue.

Analysis of public representatives' correspondence and requests for assistance has been collated which identifies particular areas that have mature trees and heavy leaf fall. This information has been matched with areas that have high pedestrian use and flood problems exacerbated by the autumn leaf fall. It is in these areas that we will attempt to provide weekly collections from volunteer groups. The Area Office will also provide bags, pickers and other equipment necessary to assist local groups.

Provisionally the areas most affected are:

- Parts of Clontarf
- Parts of Donaghmede
- Marino/Fairview
- Raheny
- Griffith Avenue

The Area Office will welcome any new groups who are properly constituted and wish to improve their areas and will be assisted as resources allow.

When specific problems arise associated with fall from public planting additional sweeping of affected paths will be arranged where possible. The North Central Office will continue to monitor requests to make certain we are using resources effectively and attending to the worst affected areas.

Clanmoyle Road – Flood Alleviation Scheme

Below is an update on the Wad Scheme since the last report in July 2013.

The Scheme has the **highest priority** of Dublin City Council, it's officials and other public representatives.

The Scheme status is at **Design Stage** (moving to construction when the necessary outstanding Statutory and Legal issues are resolved). These issues can be summarised as follows:-

- **Obtain Foreshore licence.** DCC received confirmation that the Minister approved the draft Clontarf foreshore licence. It is now being referred to the Chief State Solicitors Office and DCC's Law Agent for final drafting.

- **Finalise Design and construction drawings.** Full sets of design and construction drawings from our consulting engineer were tabled at a meeting on the 14th June in Clontarf Golf Club. As a result of the meeting a few minor adjustments are being made to them. These are now substantially finalised. Major construction quantities have been agreed with the Office of Public Works.

- **Obtain Wayleave Agreements.**

1. **Clontarf Golf Club.** Final re-instatement and landscaping details are to be tabled for agreement with Clontarf Golf Club on Monday 15th July. Wayleave drawings are agreed in principle with CGC. A 3D digital representation of the proposed changes to the 12th, 13th and 14th Holes in the Golf Club was procured. CGC called a Special General Meeting on the evening of Thursday 22nd August last. The motion to proceed with the scheme was passed unanimously by the 180+ members present. A contract is currently being drawn up between DCC Law Agent and CGC legal advisor to finalise the agreement. Discussions continue with CGC management committee.

2. **Residents.** The project team are drafting agreements for the twenty residents and landowners affected by the proposed draft wayleave drawings to obtain agreement.

3. **Irish Rail.** Irish Rail clarifications are being resolved by the project team. Peer Review requested by Irish Rail and Risk assessment – referred to DCC Consultants. A submission was sent to Irish Rail on Friday 6th September hopefully addressing all of their outstanding concerns on the scheme.

- **Carry out pre construction site investigations.** The OPW required further site investigation boreholes along the line of the proposed pipelines in the Golf club. A tender process was completed and these were carried out between 22nd July to 2nd August with the assistance of

CGC. Soils reports were received on 30th August and sent to OPW and our main consultants.

We are very appreciative of the continuing co-operation from the Golf Club in relation to various site tests and investigations and for the large degree of support shown for this project.

Construction Stage Funding Approval. The OPW as the funding authority must approve the final designs and all wayleave agreements/ foreshore Licence Agreement of Clontarf Golf Club and pre construction site investigations must be completed prior to funding application being finalised by OPW.

Liaison meetings -Numerous meetings are continually being held with stakeholders including

- o Clontarf Golf Club, their advisors, DCC, our engineering consultant, and the OPW.
- o Irish Rail and DCC.
- o CGC valuer and DCC valuer
- o DCC Traffic Department and DCC Drainage Division
- o Residents whom are directly affected by the works.

Progress updates -Local residents are being updated on progress on a regular basis or as milestones are achieved. Any resident requiring further info should contact the Project Office at 01-222 4809 or 222 4804 or by email at paul.batty@dublincity.ie.

As soon as the necessary wayleaves and other approvals are obtained (as set out above) a further report will issue.
