Dalymount Park Project

An external Project Director has been appointed and a timeline established to deliver the project with the objective of it being completed in time for the 2023 football season.

A design team is expected to be appointed in September.

Phibsborough LEIP

DCC managers are currently liaising with Roads and Traffic engineers and Parks Department to obtain their responses to design proposals put forward by Paul Keogh Architects (PKA) for five locations within a radius of Doyles Corner.

The shops from Doyles Corner down to the soldier monument have been purchased with a view to redevelopment we believe. However, no planning application or pre-planning proposal has been submitted to date.



The 4th corner buildings at the Doyles Corner intersection is currently undergoing refurbishment after a lengthy spell in dereliction. It is understood that the owners intend to lease the building for commercial purposes. This renovation is to be welcomed and is indicative of the upturn in the local economy that has seen a growth in investment in commercial units in this area.



St Finbarrs Court, Kilkieran Rd

Work is about to commence on the demolition of 2 blocks of residential flats and for site clearance to allow for the redevelopment of up to 46 one and two bedroomed apartments and a community facility.
