

Application for Licence to place an Advertisement Structure on a Public Road/Pavement

General licence conditions for placing an advertisement structure on a public footpath/road

1. General purpose

The licence refers only to the placement of an advertising structure on a public road/footpath at the specified address/location. It does not permit any other structure or advertising or the storage and display of goods at the location. The structure shall be used solely to advertise the business of the licensee.

2. Maximum Size

The advertisement structure shall be no larger than the standard A1 size (637mm x 1100mm x 800 mm) and will normally be two sided.

3. Weight and Design

The advertisement structure shall be of sufficient weight and design so as to prevent it being blown over in windy conditions and so as not to create a hazard to users of the public road/footpath. It must be portable to facilitate removal or re-positioning if required.

4. Location

The structure shall be positioned on the public footpath directly outside the property to which it relates and adjacent to the wall of the property or immediately adjacent to an area of licensed tables and chairs, if applicable.

5. Minimum Clearance Distance

A minimum of 1.8 metres unobstructed footpath width shall be available between the edge of carriageway or other street furniture (i.e. public lighting/traffic poles, bollards. litter bins etc.) and the outer edge of the advertisement structure at all times, unless otherwise determined by Dublin City Council.

6. Placement on Public Footpath

When placed on the public footpath the advertisement structure shall not:

- a) obstruct access to a bus stop, a taxi rank, a DublinBikes or other bicycle stand, or the frontage of other premises
- b) obstruct access to any service cover or similar apparatus
- c) be on or within 2 meters of any tactile paving or a dished kerb
- d) obscure the visibility of highway users on or near a junction and
- e) obscure any traffic sign or road markings
- f) be attached to any piece of street furniture including public lighting poles, wayfinding poles etc.

7. General Appearance

The advertisement structure must be kept in a clean and tidy condition, and contain no content likely to cause offence.

8. Insurance Cover

The licensee shall be required to submit for inspection to Dublin City Council, and to continue to maintain a Public Liability Insurance policy, which provides cover to a minimum value of €6.5m indemnifying Dublin City Council against third party claims associated with accident, injuries etc. caused by or contributed to by the advertisement structure.



9. Removal

The advertisement structure may only be placed on the street between the times specified on the licence and will be removed, not later than 10pm daily or when the business premises to which it relates is closed, whichever is the earlier, except in cases where written permission has been obtained from Dublin City Council,

10. Pedestrianised Footpath

In the case of pedestrianised areas where the footpath width is such that the required minimum clearance of 1.8m cannot be achieved the advertisement structure may be placed on the public roadway immediately adjacent to the carriageway edge during Pedestrianisation operating hours.

11. Renewal

The granting of a licence does not automatically guarantee renewal in subsequent years.

12. Removal, variation and damage to public road/footpath:

- a) The advertisement structure shall be removed immediately if requested by Dublin City Council. Equally, Dublin City Council reserves the right to cancel, suspend or vary the terms of the licence at any time. No claim for damages or loss of income under any heading shall be taken against Dublin City Council for suspending, cancelling or varying the terms of the licence.
- b) No claim for compensation shall be entertained in respect of damages or losses suffered as a direct or indirect consequence of the maintenance requirements of any statutory undertaker.
- c) All costs incurred by Dublin City Council, including any repairs to the public road and services necessary arising as a result of the operation of the licence, shall be at the expense of the licensee. Only Dublin City Council shall carry out work on the public road/footpath arising from the licence. The licensee shall enter into an agreement with Dublin City Council to pay for any repairs to the footpath or public roadway arising from the licence.
- d) Holes may not be made in the public road/footpath without the permission of Dublin City Council. Advertising boards may not be attached to any permanent structure.

13. Display of Licence

A copy of the licence shall be displayed prominently on the main entrance of the premises so as to be clearly visible by members of the public and officials of Dublin City Council.
