


Update



Strand Road trial

- Advance works on Strand road to start February 15th
 - Pedestrian crossing upgrades
 - > Changes to the roundabout
 - Preliminary works at Merrion Gates
- Installation of the trial to commence on Monday the 1st of March 2021
- From this date:
 - Southbound vehicular traffic only on Strand Road and Beach Road.
 - No right or left turn from Merrion Road to Strand Road.
 - ➤ All existing right turn bans from Merrion Road towards Sandymount will remain.
 - Two way traffic between Merrion gates and St Alban's Park will be maintained temporarily to facilitate local traffic until the works at Merrion Road, including the new right turn from Strand Road, are complete.






Strand Road trial

- Full traffic management will be in place on Strand road from the 1st of March
- Access to the carparks and the promenade will be maintained at all times
- 5 Axle ban in Sandymount area will be extended to 24 hours from March 1st
- 30kph speed limit on Strand road for the duration of the works
- Installation of the cycle route from St Albans to Sean Moore road expected to take 2 3 weeks
- Section from St Albans to Merrion gates will then commence
- Cycle route expected to be available by end of March

Strand Road trial Communications

- Councillors informed at the SEA meeting 8th February.
- Leaflet drop complete. Approximately 8,000 leaflets covering Sandymount, Irishtown,
 Ringsend and Ballsbridge being distributed to households
- Advance VMS signage has been put in place this week
- LiveDrive (dedicated live traffic radio) broadcasting message daily to motorists
- Community Forum meetings will continue throughout trial
- Google maps and sat-nav companies have been informed of the changes
- Updates will be posted on the Strand trial webpage



Potential Mitigation Measures for discussion



As discussed at previous Forum:

- In response to submissions received DCC looked at some measures which could improve cycling safety within the village
- These were presented to the South East Area committee who were informed that they would be discussed at this Forum
- These are to allow a discussion to take place, concerns or suggestions to be raised. It does not form any part of a DCC scheme at present but if there is broad agreement then we would be prepared to look at it in more detail
