Progress made on the Three-bed list. ➤ Dumping on sites remains an issue and a drain on Resources. ➤ TAU spending 90% time taking away rubbish. ➤ P S implementing new waste initiatives on sites. ➤ Labre Park/ Belcamp Lane/ Newtown Court are main sites with waste issues. ➤ TAU supporting summer Programme in Bridgeview community center. ➤ Community Programme to be developed and extend to all sites. ➤ Support offered to work with residents regarding mental health on Belcamp/Newtown Court. ➤ TAU continue to work with waste enforcement to find solutions. ➤ It was suggested that restorative practices might be needed with the residents of Nass road regarding the culturally appropriate isolation units. ➤ TAU supports this suggestion if absolutely needed. ➤ It was stated that the Nass road site has benefited from the clean-up of the site.
