## Terms and conditions

- 1. Only the Licence Holder may engage in Casual Trading.
- 2. The licence holder must prominently display the number of the licence at his or her trading place in such a way as to be clearly visible and easily legible to members of the public.
- 3. If requested the Licence Holder shall produce his/her licence on demand to any person.
- 4. No goods other than those specified in the licence (CD's and DVD's of artists own original work) may be sold.
- 5. The licence holder shall not obstruct any business, premises, footpath, public road or public right of way.
- 6. The licence holder shall not conduct trading in a manner that causes or is likely to cause offence.
- 7. The licence holder must have a current valid tax clearance certificate in place at all times.
- 8. The licence may be revoked at any time if any condition of the licence has been or is being contravened.
- 9. A person who contravenes any of the conditions of the licence shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding €1,270.

## Street Performer Casual Trading Licence for the sale of CD's and DVD's - GDPR

### Reasons for requesting your personal information

- Your information is required in order to process your application for a Street Performers Casual Trading licence for the sale of CD's and DVD's.
- Your information is collected to process requests for a Casual Trading Licence. The legal basis is provided for under the Casual Trading Act 1995 and the Casual Trading Bye-Laws 2013.
- If your application is successful it may be necessary to share your information with other statutory bodies i.e. An Garda Siochána, Revenue Commissioners, Minister for Social Welfare.
- If the Casual Trading Licence is granted, the information supplied by you will be kept securely for a period of seven years.
- If you do not provide the personal data required under the Casual Trading Act 1995 and the Casual Trading Bye-Laws 2013, Dublin City Council will not be in a position to process your application.
