What is the Street Cleaning schedule for my area?

All streets within Dublin City Councils administrative area are cleaned in accordance with our Grading System. High footfall locations such as the city centre are cleaned several times a day, while other high footfall locations such as suburban villages and main thoroughfares and cleaned once a day. Residential areas are cleaned periodically and local management teams inspect streets daily and deploy resources to areas requiring urgent attention.

How can I help to keep my neighbourhood clean?

Use litter bins. Use a litter bin to dispose of all litter. If a bin is not available, please bring your litter home.

Pick up after your pets. If you have pets that go for walks, especially dogs, make sure you pick up after them. Not picking up after your dog can result in a fine of up to €150.

Organise a Community Clean-up. Across the city, residents arrange community cleanups. Why not join in? Dublin City Council will provide the equipment needed and remove rubbish collected.

All streets within Dublin City Councils administrative area are cleaned in accordance with our Grading System. **Category A** streets are cleaned on a 24 hour basis; **Category B** streets are cleaned from 6am to 9pm; **Category C** streets are cleaned from 6am to 1:30pm. Autumn Leaf Collection

Dublin City Council collects hundreds of tonnes of fallen leaves from the City Streets each Autumn. Main thoroughfares and arterial routes into the city are cleared on an ongoing basis during this time.

In residential areas where it is not possible to provide the same frequency of service many residents groups, associations and individuals get involved in helping to manage their own areas by carrying out leaf clearing initiatives.

Dublin City Council provides bags and equipment to these groups and removes all of the collected bagged leaves.
