Vesting Order

1. Whereas the land described in the **Schedule** hereto and shown on the map **attached** hereto which said map has been marked

'Map referred to in Vesting Order made under s. 17 of the *Derelict Sites Act 1990 (as amended by the Planning and Development Act 2000)* on the **5th May, 2022** by Dublin City Council'

is a derelict site within the meaning of the *Derelict Sites Act 1990 (as amended by the Planning and Development Act 2000)* (hereinafter called 'the Act');

2. And whereas the provisions of s. 15 of the Act have been complied with by Dublin City Council (hereinafter called 'the Council') in relation to the said land;

3. And whereas no objection has been submitted to the Council under s. 16 of the Act;

4. Now therefore the Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by s. 17 of the Act, hereby order that the land described in the Schedule hereto shall, on **2nd June, 2022**, vest in the Council in fee simple free from encumbrances and all estates, rights, titles and interests of whatsoever kind.




All that and those the lands known as **10 Mulberry Cottages, Martin's Row, Chapelizod,** ¹⁰⁰¹
