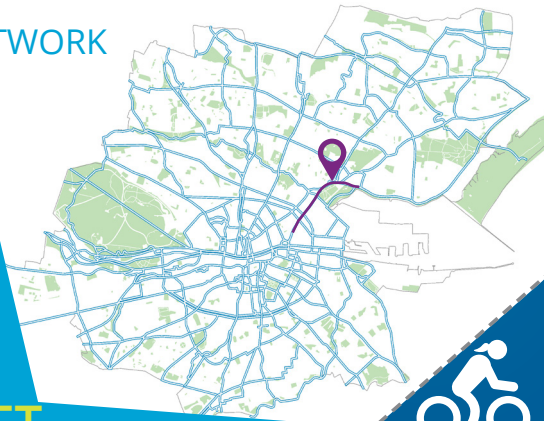


Clontarf to City Centre Project

INFORMATION LEAFLET



The Clontarf to City Centre Project (C2CC Project) is part of the Dublin City Council (DCC) core active travel network, and is funded by the National Transport Authority (NTA).

It will provide high quality 8km of walking and 6km of cycling facilities, 5.4km of bus priority infrastructure, improved greening, public domain and utility upgrades, along with the replacement of 6km of 100 year old watermain. This scheme extends from Clontarf Road (at the junction with Alfie Byrne Road) to Amiens Street (at the junction with Talbot Street).

This leaflet provides information on some milestones and the proposed temporary traffic management plans.

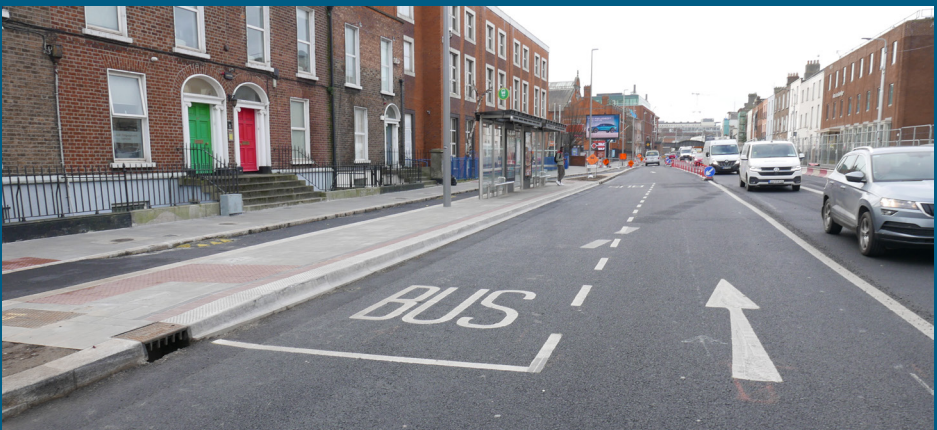
1 A THANK YOU TO THE COMMUNITY

2 PROGRESS UPDATE



Works have greatly progressed on the inbound side of Amiens Street between Buckingham Street and Five Lamps junction



Three of the proposed bus stops along the route are complete and have been opened



Paving and landscaping along the route continues



Reconstruction of historic stone wall on North Strand Road



Road re-construction at each of the major junctions along the route continues



Works are greatly progressed on the inbound side through Fairview and the Park



Bespoke designed tree pits are being installed to support new trees on the scheme



Approximately 6km of 100 year old watermain are being replaced throughout the route

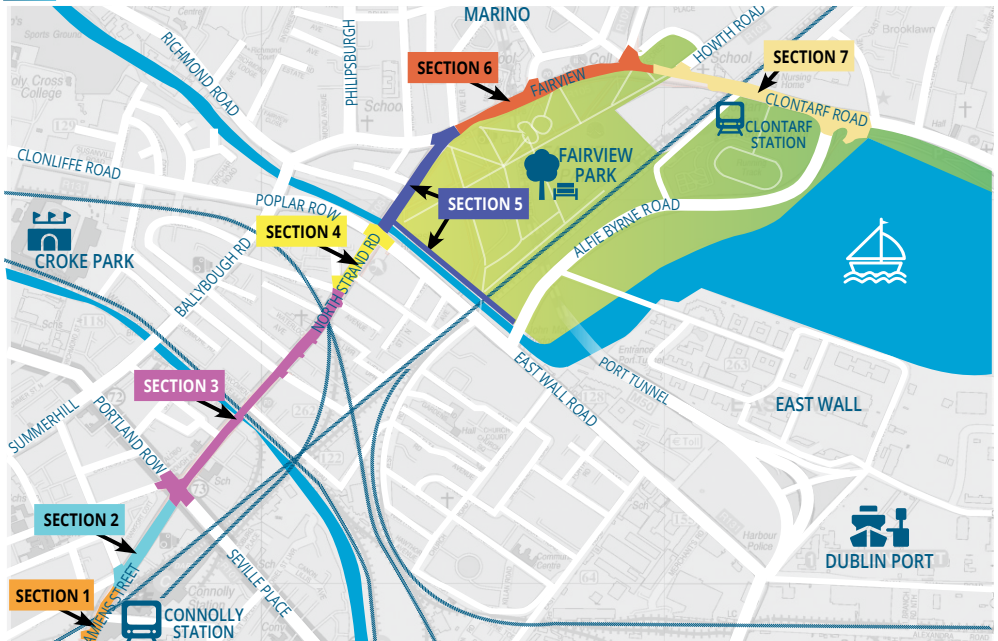


New planting, benches and paving installed to form a plaza at the Fairview footbridge

3 PROGRAMME OF WORKS



These are the indicative programme dates related to the sections outlined on the project map above:

- **Section 1** (Talbot Street to Buckingham Street Lower) - works to commence on inbound side in March
- **Section 2** (Buckingham Street Lower to Five Lamps Junction) - substantial works complete on inbound and works commenced on outbound side in February
- **Section 3** (Five Lamps Junction to Annesley Place junction) - works ongoing on inbound side. Intention to swap works to outbound side in Summer 2023
- **Section 4** (Annesley Place junction to Annesley Bridge) - works ongoing on inbound side. Intention to swap works to outbound side in Summer 2023
- **Section 5** (Annesley Bridge to Edge's Corner) - works ongoing on Inbound side. Intention to swap works to outbound side in Summer 2023
- **Section 6** (Edge's Corner to Howth Road Junction) - works ongoing on Inbound side. Intention to swap works to outbound side end of March/early April 2023
- **Section 7** (Howth Road Junction to Alfie Byrne Road Junction) - works ongoing on inbound and outbound. Works expected to be substantially complete on inbound side in early Summer 2023

By Q3 of 2023 works will have substantially moved to the outbound side
