Mary Street Traffic Free




Dublin City Council are proposing to make the section of Mary Street between Wolfe Tone Street and Jervis Lane Upper Traffic Free from Monday the 27th of March 2023.

This will be a similar arrangement to the section of Mary Street between Jervis Lane Upper and Capel Street and will provide more space for pedestrians and reduce vehicles in the local street network. Deliveries will be facilitated daily between 6am and 11am.

From this date:

- Mary Street between Wolfe Tone Street and Jervis Lane Upper will become traffic free
- Deliveries will be facilitated every day between 6am and 11am
- The disabled parking bay on Mary Street will be relocated to Wolfe Tone Street
- The one parking space on Mary Street will be removed

The proposal will provide a link between current pedestrian streets (Mary Street and Henry Street) and the Traffic Free Capel Street creating a pedestrian priority route from O'Connell Street to the Markets area
