We go through the doors on the left to enter the library

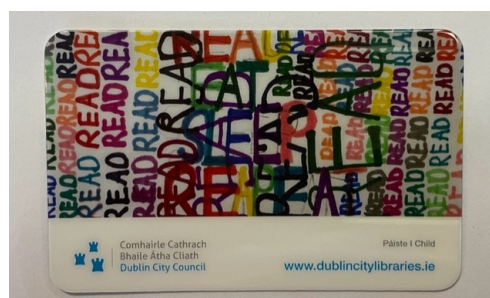




Once we enter the library we can go to the desk to see the Librarian.

We also have a selection of sensory toys. Just ask someone at the desk and we can bring them out.

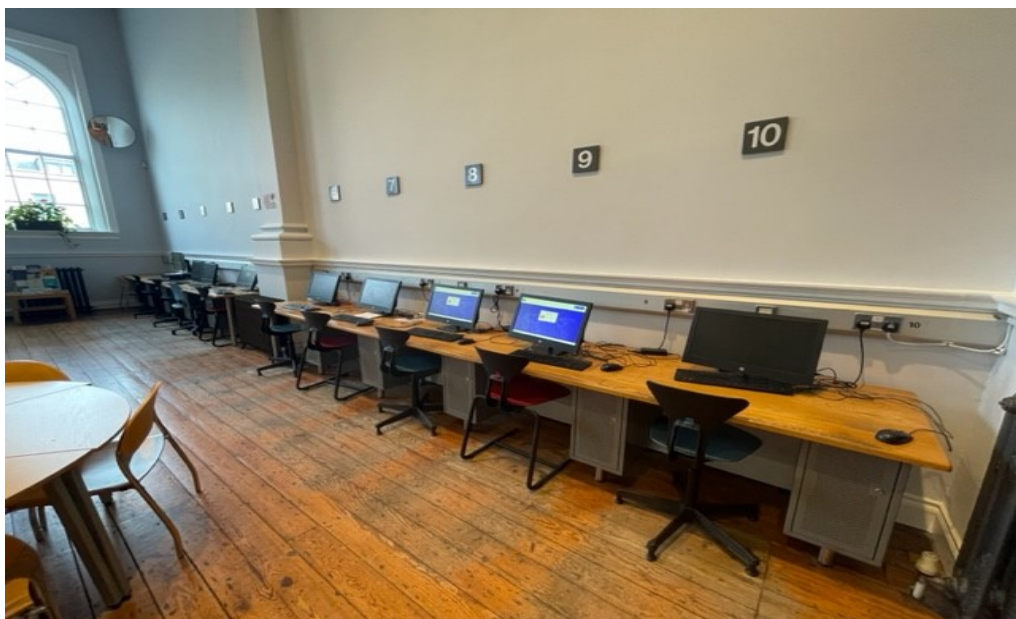




In the main part of the library there are also places to study and read.
