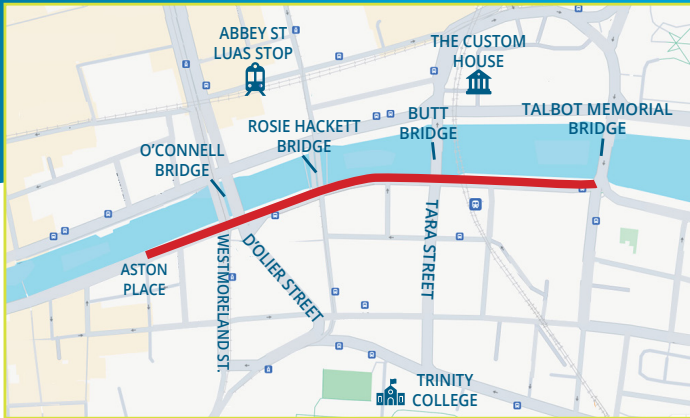
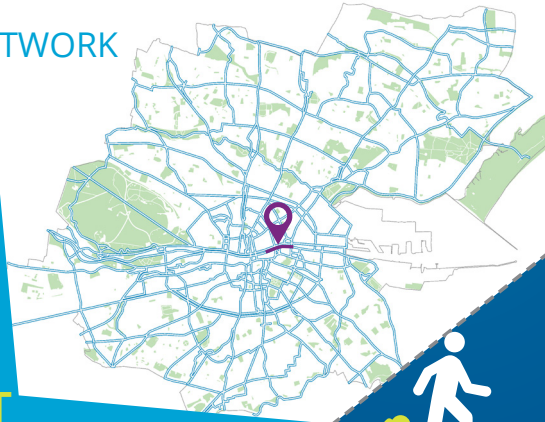


The Liffey Cycle Route

The Georges Quay to Aston Quay section of the Liffey Cycle Route is part of Dublin City Council's (DCC) Active Travel Network. This scheme will upgrade the existing road layout, improving walking and cycling facilities. It will also provide safer crossing points from Talbot Memorial Bridge to Aston Place on Aston Quay.

Construction of the project is due to commence in March 2024 and be completed before the end of Q2 2025. In order to deliver this complex but worthwhile project, there will be some unavoidable temporary disruption to the area. DCC, in collaboration with our contractor will endeavour to minimise this as much as possible.

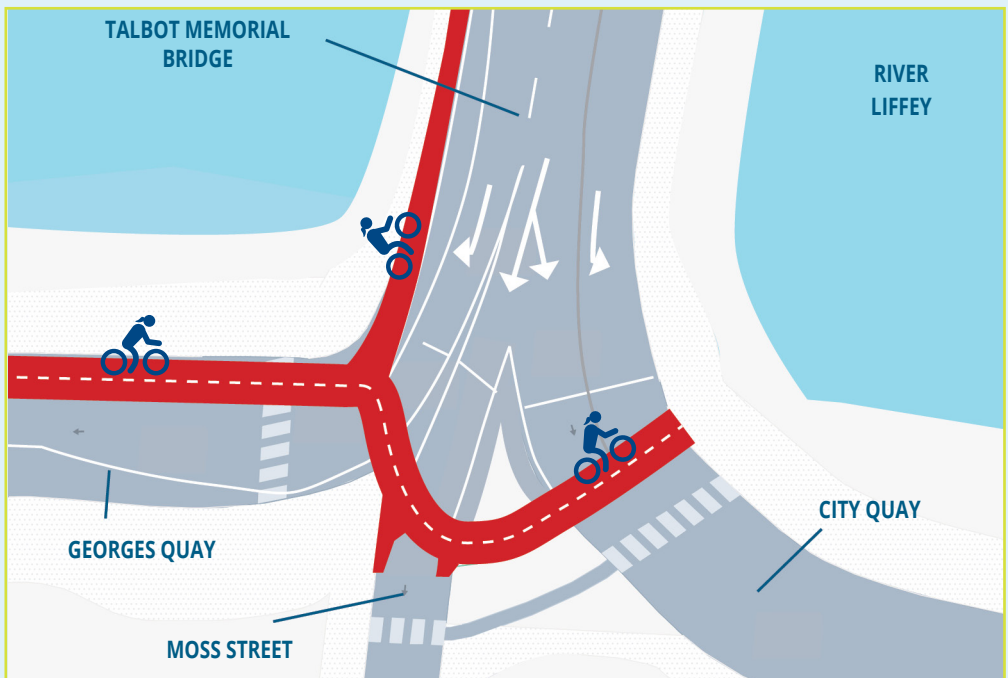

1 PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Liffey Cycle Route - Georges Quay to Aston Quay section will:

- Provide improved segregated two-way cycle facilities from Talbot Bridge to O'Connell Bridge
- Improve crossing facilities for cyclists and pedestrians
- Reduce number of traffic lanes from two to one, while maintaining the bus lane (see Section 2 - Photomontages)
- Improve carriageway surface
- Encourage walking and cycling in the area by providing improved facilities
- Contribute to a reduction in transport emissions in line with the objectives of the Climate Action Plan by encouraging a modal shift to active travel and public transport use

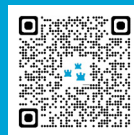
