Sa chéad bhliain dom mar Phríomhfheidhmeannach Chomhairle Cathrach Bhaile Átha Cliath, is ábhar lúcháire agus mórtais dom fáilte a chur romhaibh go léir cur isteach ar Chomórtas Chomharsanachtaí na Cathrach, 2024, agus an comórtas ag ceiliúradh 20 bliain ar an bhfód. Ó tháinig mé isteach sa ról seo, chuaigh sé i gcion orm líon ard na ngrúpaí deonacha pobail a bhfuil tionchar mór á imirt acu sa chathair seo againn. Tá sé tábhachtach, mar sin de, go dtabharfaimis aitheantas agus luach saothair don obair a dhéantar gach uile lá, seachtain nó mí fud fad na cathrach seo.

Le Comórtas Chomharsanachtaí na Cathrach, lenar tugadh le chéile Comórtas na dTithe Cónaithe, Comórtas na nGnólachtaí agus Comórtas na Scoileanna, cothaítear mórtas cathartha, mórtas áite agus mórtas pobail agus cuirtear chun cinn feasacht ar an gcomhshaol. Cuirtear béim láidir ar iarracht dheonach/phobail. Ar na nithe a chuireann le marcanna arda, tá na bearta a dhéantar chun srian a choinneáil le bruscar agus graifítí, chun imeachtaí pobail a eagrú a bheadh ionchuiimsitheach ar bhonn sóisialta agus chun bheith ag obair i gcomhpháirt le Comhairle Cathrach Bhaile Átha Cliath. Is éard is bunaidhm leis an gcomórtas ná timpeallacht níos glaine, níos glaise a bhaint amach mar aon le ceantair áitiúla níos tarraingtí a rachaidh chun sochair an uile chuirteora agus an uile chónaitheora sa chathair.

Leis an 20ú bliain a chomórach, tugaim cuireadh daoibh bhur “dTionscadal Speisialta” a chur isteach.

I gcomhpháirt le d’oifig cheantair áitiúil, d’fhéadfá limistéir a shainiúint a bhfuil clú orthu as an mbruscar a bhíonn iontu agus iad a ghlacadh chugat féin lena bhfeabhsú, i gcomhpháirt le CCBÁC, agus le scoileanna agus gnólachtaí áitiúla. D’fhéadfadh sibh ansin an “Tionscadal Speisialta” seo a chur isteach ar an gcomórtas chun deis a bheith agaibh duais a bhuanach.

Tá sé beartaithe againn freisin leanúint arís eile i mbliana den tionscnamh Glantachán Fhoireann Bhaile Átha Cliath arís ar an 27 Aibreán i gcomhpháirt le mí an Ghlantacháin Earraigh Náisiúnta. Mholfaínn daoibh go léir tosú ar an obair agus tabhairt faoin nglantachán is fearr agus is mó tionchar riamh i mbliana chun braistint an bhróid a thabhairt ar ais chuig an gcathair seo againn.

Deis eile atá anseo chun cur isteach ar an gcomórtas chun deis a bheith agaibh duais a bhuanach.

Voluntary Community effort	50%
Absence of litter/graffiti	25%
Landscaping/biodiversity (where relevant)	15%
Overall impression	10%

SCHOOLS COMPETITION

Primary and Secondary Schools are invited to enter this competition. Marks will be awarded under the following judging criteria:

Upkeep of school’s precinct (landscaping/biodiversity/absence of litter and graffiti)	40%
Waste Management/Recycling Initiatives	25%
Water Conservation//Energy Efficiency Initiatives	25%
Special Environmental Projects	10%

Award ceremony for Schools competition will be held at a daytime reception in December of each year in the Mansion House by the Lord Mayor (or Deputy Lord Mayor).
