
## **Welcome to Charleville Mall Library**

This section has books for older readers from 12 to 15 years old.




Sometimes people study or do their homework in the library.

## I can use the bathroom if I need to during my visit. I can find the bathroom beside the library desk.




Sometimes I will visit the Events Room for storytelling or to meet an author.
