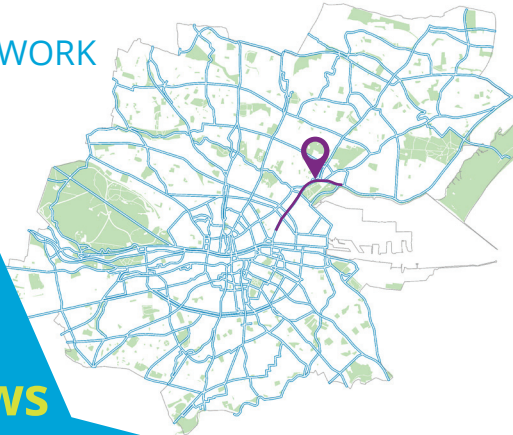


## Clontarf to City Centre Project **PUBLIC SAFETY MESSAGE** For Drivers, Cyclists & Pedestrians



## Flashing Amber Arrows

Dublin City Council is working to provide a safer Active Travel Network by rolling out flashing amber arrows for left turning vehicles at junctions.



- 1** Cyclists have priority over turning vehicles when travelling straight through any junction
- 2** Flashing amber arrows are a reminder of this for drivers
- 3** They will be installed at a number of junctions along the Clontarf to City Centre Scheme

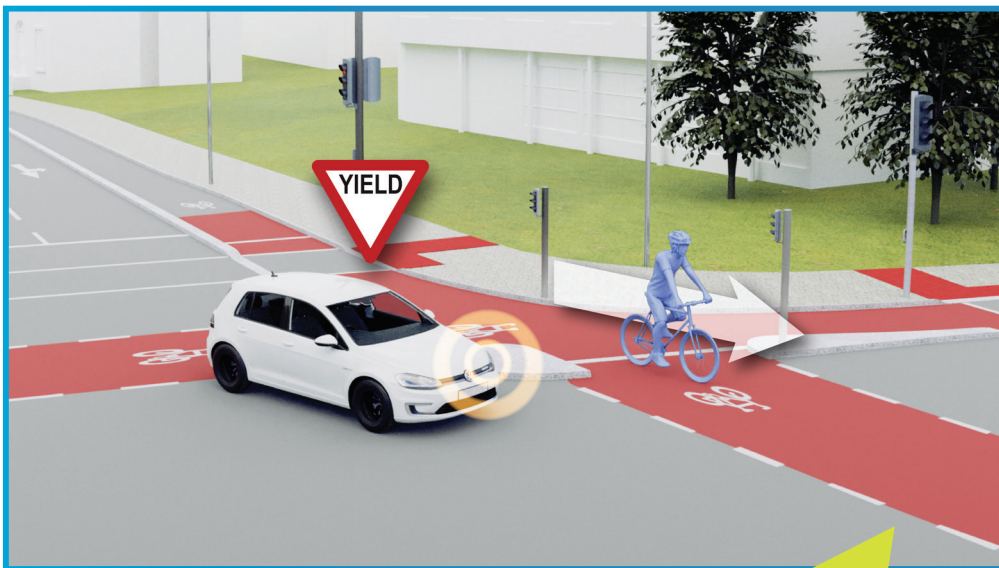

## ATTENTION DRIVERS

Before making a turn you must:

- 1 Yield to approaching cyclists
- 2 Allow cyclists time to clear the junction
- 3 Proceed to make your turn, when it's safe to do so
