You can ring or email the library before you visit at (01) 222 8490 or coolocklibrary@dublincity.ie if there is something that you would like to know before you come.






These are library cards.

You can join the library for free and use your library card to borrow books, DVDs, CDs, magazines and games.

You can borrow up to 12 items for 3 weeks.

You can borrow or return books and other items at the library desk or you can use the self service kiosk.





This is the adult library.

The adult library is normally quiet. People can study and read a book.



This is where we keep our CDs and DVDs.





Our magazine shelf is inside the door to the right.



We have audiobooks on MP3 and CD that you can borrow.



We have large print books that can be borrowed.

We have quick reads and dyslexia friendly books.



There are comfortable chairs to relax on.





When choosing your books, we have a trolley that you can use.



This is what the young adult corner looks like.

Our young adult section is for ages 12-17.

The collection also includes exam guides.



There are computers that you can use at the back of the adult library. You will need your library card number and PIN to log on.

PCs are for adult card holders only.



There is a photocopier, printer and scanner that you can use.



There are tables in the library you can sit at to read, study or do homework.

We have two private study rooms that can be booked at the desk.





Sometimes it can be busy and noisy, you can ask to use our ear defenders if needed.




You can ask about events that may be on in the Library.

We have 3 event rooms










This is the Maker Space.
