Here is the front desk








Welcome to the children's library








I can read books, colour pictures, or sit and relax.




Here is a library card

Here is a kiosk




This is where I can borrow and return books. I can ask a librarian if I need help.



This is the adult library






The grown-up books are here.

This is the toilet






I can find the toilet in the room at the back of the children's library.
