If you are aged 12 - 17, your library card will look like this.




If you are at least 18 years old, your library card will look like this.

When you scan your library card, you will hear a beep. Please ask us if you are unsure about how to use the Self Service kiosk.




When you return a book at the Self Service kiosk, it will tell you to either place it on the returns trolley or in the drop box. This is what the trolley looks like.

There are magazines in the library that you can borrow.




You can study or do your homework at the study tables in the library.




# There are comfy chairs that you can sit on.



There is a photocopier, a printer and a scanner for you to use.




There are two computers that you can use. You need your library card number and PIN. You will get these when you join the library. If it's busy, we'll tell you when they will be next available.
