A Social Story








Welcome to our Social Story

We can visit Inchicore Library at Richmond Barracks at the following times:


Monday 10am to 5pm Tuesday 10am to 5pm Wednesday 10am to 5pm Thursday 10am to 5pm

Getting to Inchicore Library at Richmond Barracks

Inchicore Library at Richmond Barracks is located in inchicore, Dublin 8

The eircode is D08 YY05 and Google Maps Plus Code is 8MQM+8G Dublin.

The building is situated off Bulfin Road, near the corner of Emmet Road (R810), behind St. Michael's Church. It faces St. Michael's Estate green space










This is the main entrance to Inchicore Library within Richmond Barracks

Here is a Library Card




I can use this card to borrow books, movies, magazines and even games from the library!

Toilets

Two gender-neutral, individual toilets are at the end of the corridor in Richmond Barracks.


There are also three gender-neutral, individual toilets on the left-hand side of the gym. This room also contains baby-changing facilities.

Sensory Toys

We have a large range of sensory toys available at the library. I can play with these at anytime, just ask at the main desk.

We also have a sensory playtime morning, on the second Monday of each month at 11am.

If it gets too loud in the library, I can ask the librarian for ear defenders.







The Garden

A large garden space at the back of the library is accessible through a door to the left of the reception desk. The garden is wheelchair accessible and buggy, child and dog friendly. Ask any staff member if you need help finding it.

I can go outside to the garden to play, read or relax.





If I need anything, I can ask a library assistant.
