



Visiting Kevin Street Library A Social Story

Welcome to the Library!



With a library card I can borrow books, comics, DVDs and more. I can use the public computers or borrow a laptop with my library card.

If I need help I can talk to the library staff. They can help me to find what I am looking for.



When I come in the main door I will see a hallway. From here I can go to the main library, or upstairs to the study area.

In the main library area I will see the library counter, some desks with computers, and lots of bookshelves.



Kevin Street Library has three public computers. I can use them by logging in with my library card.

I can use the bathroom if I need to during my visit. I can find the bathroom in the main library room, near the public computers.



This is the reading room.

I can sit and read here.

I can also find books, audiobooks, magazines and newspapers here.



This is the printing station. I can print, scan and photocopy pages here.

Printing will cost 20c per page if I print in black and white.

If I need help, I can ask the library staff.



This is the Junior Library. Here children can read, do homework, colour in pictures and play games.

The Junior Library can be noisy sometimes! I can wear Ear Defenders if it gets loud.



This is the library study space. I can read or study quietly here. I can also borrow a laptop using my library card.

The study space is upstairs. I can use the stairs or take the lift to level 1.



I can borrow a laptop from the LapSafe cabinet to use in the library. To borrow a laptop I need to use my library card and PIN (password).

I can borrow a laptop for up to 3 hours. I must return it 15 minutes before the library closes.



I can borrow books using a self-service kiosk or by asking at the library counter. I can return books the same way.
