It sets out a vision for the next five years and outlines ambitious goals that will help make this vision a reality.




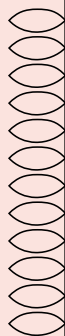
OUR GOALS FOR THE CITY

GOAL

Develop accessible,
safe, high quality social
and affordable homes

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- Accelerate the supply of homes.
 - Reduce homelessness and ensure that those experiencing, or at risk of, homelessness receive high quality services.
 - Maintain inclusive housing where vibrant communities grow and people are proud to live.



GOAL

Grow a network of thriving neighbourhoods where everyone can access quality services that support inclusive communities

- Expand and enhance the City's community, cultural, sports, parks and recreational facilities.
- Protect and restore biodiversity by working with local communities and other agencies.
- Promote cohesion through social inclusion and community development programmes including Irish language programmes and activities.
- Build a sense of belonging and pride by celebrating Dublin's unique character.



GOAL

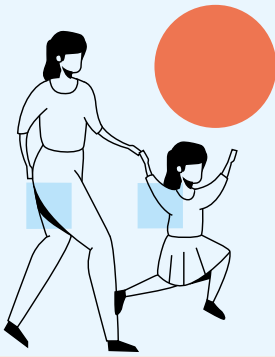
Guide Dublin's development so it becomes one of Europe's most dynamic city regions

- Guide the city's spatial development to enhance quality of life, economic competitiveness, cultural heritage and environmental resilience.
- Co-create a smart, green, innovative economy with our economic and tourism partners.
- Regenerate, develop and reuse land and buildings to revitalise areas across the city.
- Lead the revitalisation of the city centre to create a clean, safe, accessible and thriving capital.



GOAL

Create and maintain a clean, green, healthy, safe and well-connected city with a vibrant public realm



- Create one of the cleanest cities in Europe.
- Maintain and renew the public realm to create safe, accessible and enjoyable public spaces.
- Provide an accessible low traffic environment to support sustainable transport and public realm improvements.
- Create an Active Travel Network to transform how people walk, wheel and cycle.
- Complete the transition of water services to Uisce Éireann.

GOAL

Lead and advocate for the City's transition to a low-carbon and climate resilient future

- Lead the collaborative effort to change behaviour and systems to deliver on climate goals.
- Significantly reduce greenhouse gas emissions in our operations.
- Strengthen Dublin's capacity to prevent and adapt to the effects of climate change.
- Successfully manage the city's surface water drainage systems and water bodies.
- Improve the city's environment, including its air quality.
- Improve emergency responses and empower communities to stay safe.
