Life Satisfaction

• **6.7 out of 10** is the average life satisfaction score among respondents. This is down slightly on the level measured in December 2024 (6.8)

Feeling Safe in the City Centre

• **64%** of respondents felt safe in the city centre during the (down from 68% in December 2024). **33%** felt safe in the city centre at night - down from 35% in December 2024.

Engaging in activities between 6pm and 6am

• A majority of respondents engaged in activities such as "Everyday tasks (shopping / personal errands)" (68% engaging), "Socialising at home / in a private residence" (66%), "Eating out" (64%), "Socialise somewhere other than a pub" (58%), "Socialise in a pub or bar" (57%).

Barriers to going out at night in Dublin more

• The most commonly cited barriers to going out at night in Dublin more were "It's too expensive to go out in Dublin at night" (50% selecting in top 3 barriers), "I do not feel safe in Dublin at night" (42%) and "It is difficult for me to get home at night" (28%).

Priorities for night-time experience

• The top 3 priorities for the night-time experience were "Better safety at night" (63% selecting in top 3), "Improved night-time transport" (55%) and "More free / low-cost activities" (28%)



Perceptions of the evening-time economy – 6pm – 12 midnight

- 92% of respondents agreed that "The evening-time economy is important to the overall Dublin economy"
- 88% agreed "The evening-time economy makes a positive contribution to Dublin's cultural life"
- 79% agreed that "More evening-time options are needed where I live"
- 77% agreed that "More evening-time options are needed in Dublin City Centre

Perceptions of the night-time economy - 12 midnight - 6pm

- 79% of respondents agreed that "The night-time economy is important to the overall Dublin economy"
- 71% agreed "The night-time economy makes a positive contribution to Dublin's cultural life"
- 66% agreed that "More night-time options are needed in Dublin City Centre
- 50% agreed that "More night-time options are needed where I live"

Availability of Facilities - 12 midnight to 3am

- The top 4 facilities of which respondents felt more were needed from 12 midnight to 3am were
 - Performance spaces (64%)
 - Music venues (61%)
 - Cafés (61%)
 - Cultural venues (60%)

Availability of Facilities - 3am to 6am

- The top 4 facilities of which respondents felt more were needed from 3am to 6am were
 - Dance venues (46%)
 - Music venues (44%)
 - Cafés (42%)
 - Performance spaces (42%)



Travel and International Comparisons

- **45%** of respondents indicated that they travel abroad for leisure at least every few months. The pattern of traveling abroad for leisure is similar to that observed in both February 2020 and August 2023.
- Among those with a basis for comparison, **78%** rate Dublin's nightlife poorer, and **7%** rate Dublin's nightlife better than the nightlife in the cities they have visited abroad (in line with results from August 2023).
- Berlin, London and Amsterdam were the cities most commonly selected in the top 3 European cities for nightlife, similar to February 2020 and August 2023.
- **5%** of respondents placed Dublin in their top 3 European cities for nightlife. This is down from 13% in February 2020, and in line with the figure recorded in August 2023.

Night-time Economy Advisor

• 41% of respondents were aware of the role of Night-time Economy Advisor.

Night-time Economy Strategy

• 26% of respondents were aware of the Night-time Economy Strategy which was published in October 2024.

Night-time Economy Strategy - Suggestions for Additions

• When prompted for suggestions as to what, if anything, could be added to the pillars of the night-time economy strategy, common suggestions related to commerce and economy (including more options / better value for money), accessibility and inclusion, and cleanliness / maintenance / sustainability.



Nocturnal Beats

- 14% of respondents were aware of "Nocturnal Beats" that happened on Culture Night 2024. Of these 1 in 4 had participated in Nocturnal Beats.
- 76% of those who had participated in the Nocturnal Beats late-night trail rated it as good or excellent.
- 47% of respondents indicated that they would be somewhat (35%) or very likely (12%) to participate in Nocturnal Beats if it were repeated in 2025.

Comedy Culture in the Capital

- 21% of respondents were aware of the Comedy Culture in the Capital festival that took place in November 2024. Of these 1 in 4 had participated in some part of the festival.
- 81% of those who had attended any part of the Comedy Culture in the Capital festival rated it as good or excellent
- **55%** of respondents indicated that they would be somewhat (39%) or very likely (16%) to attend the Comedy Culture in the Capital festival if it were repeated in 2025.

Welfare Area / Safe Space

- 26% of respondents were aware of the Welfare Area / Safe Space initiative at College Green in December 2024. 11 respondents had availed of the services of the Welfare Area / Safe Space during its trial.
- 7 of those who had availed of the service rated it as good or excellent.
- **75%** of respondents felt that the Welfare Area / Safe Space initiative should be continued on a permanent basis, and a further 23% felt that it would depend on the outcome of the trial period.









- Robust panel in existence since 2010, recruitment through various channels










Monthly Income After Taxes, Before Bills





Monthly Disposable Income After Bills Are Paid




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Life Satisfaction


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Feeling Safe in the City Centre - Trend



Engaging in activities between 6pm and 6am at least once a month % of respondents




Engaging in activities between 6pm and 6am % of respondents












How often, if ever, do you travel abroad for leisure?

How does Dublin's nightlife compare with the nightlife in cities you have visited abroad?




78% rate Dublin's nightlife poorer, 7% rate Dublin's nightlife better in line with figures recorded in Q3 2023

The top 4 cities were also the top 4 cities in Q1 2020, and Q3 2023, in the same order


5% of respondents placed Dublin in their top 3 European cities for nightlife.



There are three key pillars to Dublin City's night-time economy strategy, as follows:

- **1. Cultural Activity** developing new cultural programming, encouraging public art installations and cultivating venue partnerships.
- 2. Mobility and Transport advocating for responsive public transport and ensuring venues are accessible to all.
- **3. Safety** creating safe spaces, helping to improve security, promoting inclusion & diversity training and enhancing lighting and security measures in high-traffic nightlife areas.





How would you rate the Nocturnal Beats late-night trail?





12% of respondents indicated that they would be very likely to participate in the Nocturnal Beats late-night trail if held on Culture Night in 2025




Were you aware of the Comedy Culture in the Capital festival before today?

Did you attend any part of the Comedy Culture in the Capital festival in November 2024?




1 in 4 of those who had heard of the Comedy Culture in the Capital festival had attended some part of the festival in 2024

How would you rate the Comedy Culture in the Capital festival?




81% of those who had attended any part of the Comedy Culture in the Capital festival rated it as good or excellent

16% of respondents indicated that they would be very likely to attend the Comedy Culture in the Capital festival if it were to take place again in 2025

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
Awareness of Welfare Area / Safe Space



Welfare Area / Safe Space

In late December 2024 Dublin City Council piloted a Welfare Area / Safe Space at Foster Place, College Green. This initiative provided a "welfare / safe area" in a key nightlife spot for people needing assistance during late-night hours. This was provided in partnership with local service and staffed by Medics, Security and Welfare personnel.


Were you aware of this initiative before today?

Did you avail of any of the services provided by the Welfare Area / Safe Space initiative during its trial?




4% of those who were aware of the Welfare Area / Safe Space initiative availed of its services during its trial (11 individuals)

How would you rate the services provided by the Welfare Area / Safe Space initiative?




68% of those who had availed of the services of the Welfare Area / Safe Space initiative rated the services as good or excellent
