- Location 3: Merrion Square South, Merrion Square East, Fitzwilliam Street Lower and Mount Street Upper, Dublin 2 from 06.00hrs to 22.00hrs on Saturday 28th June 2025.

Traffic Management Plan

- Pedestrian access will be maintained.
- Diversions for other traffic will be in place as follows:
 - Eastbound traffic from Sarsfield Quay towards <u>North City</u>, will be diverted via Blackhall Place, Manor Street, Prussia Street, North Circular Road, Portland Row, Seville Place and Guild Street.
 - Eastbound traffic from Sarsfield Quay towards <u>South City</u>, will be diverted via Watling Street, Thomas Street and onto High Street.
 - Westbond traffic from North Wall Quay towards <u>North City</u> will be diverted via Guild Street, Seville Place, Portland Row, North Circular Road, Dorset Street Lower, Dorset Street Upper, Bolton Street, King Street North and Queen Street.
 - Westbond traffic from North Wall Quay towards <u>South City</u> will be diverted via Samuel Beckett Bridge, Sir Rogerson's Quay, Cardiff Lane, Macken Street, Grand Canal Street Lower, Grand Canal Street Upper, Haddington Road, Mespil Road, Leeson Street Lower, St Stephen's Green, Cuffe Street, Redmond's Hill, Augier Street, South Great George's Street.
