

The Fitzwilliam Quay to Londonbridge Road Active Travel Scheme will provide 0.5km of high-quality walking and cycling facilities from Fitzwilliam Quay to Londonbridge Road, as part of the Dodder Greenway. The Dodder Greenway is being developed to be a world-class greenway. When complete, it will provide a premium walk-wheel-cycle route along the River Dodder corridor, from Bohernabreena in the Dublin Mountains to the River Liffey in Ringsend.

During construction we will keep disruption to a minimum.










1 SCHEME DETAILS

To make it safer, easier and more pleasant to walk, wheel or cycle, this scheme provides:

- A new signalised junction at Bridge Street / Fitzwilliam Quay
- A two-way protected cycle track along the riverside of Fitzwilliam Quay.
 To enable this, parking will be removed on the riverside. The existing path will remain unchanged
- A cycle track adjacent to the footpath through Dodder Park
- Upgrading Londonbridge Road to a shared area for both motorists and cyclists

All existing boundaries and trees along the route will be retained.
