

Processing notifications during the transition from Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006 to Regulation (EU) 2024/1157

Introduction

Further to the briefing notice issued¹ on 2 September 2025, this document provides additional details on how the NTFSO will handle and process notifications during the transition from Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006 to Regulation (EU) 2024/1157. As previously stated, notifications that are properly carried out and receive an acknowledgment from the competent authority (CA) of destination before 21 May 2026², will continue to be regulated under the provisions of Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006. However, to ensure minimum disruption to notifiers and CAs, several other measures are required to be implemented. In defining these measures, the NTFSO has consulted with a number of other CAs to try and align key dates, where possible.

Measures

1. Notification Submission Deadline

If a notification is submitted in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006 but is not acknowledged by the CA of destination before 21 May 2026, the notifier will need to resubmit the notification on DIWASS and start their application again. To keep such instances to a minimum, the NTFSO will require all notifications under this Regulation to be submitted by Friday, 27 February 2026.

Notifications that need to be renewed/submitted between 27 February – 21 July 2026 should be submitted in advance of this deadline, allowing sufficient time for assessment and transmission. Where possible, notifications should be submitted on a phased basis to allow NTFSO staff sufficient time for processing in accordance with the regulatory timelines.

It should be noted that poor-quality notifications and those that require multiple further information requests will take longer to transmit to the CA of destination and will thus be at a much greater risk of not receiving an acknowledgement before 21 May 2026.

2. Submitting Notifications with a first date of shipment after 21 July 2026

If a notification has a first date of shipment after 21 July 2026, it should only be submitted from 21 May 2026 onwards. DIWASS will be live from that date for both CAs and notifiers, thus enabling a notification to be submitted and assessed.

3. B3011 Plastic Notifications to OECD countries e.g. Great Britain, Türkiye

As previously advised, shipments of B3011 to OECD countries are required to be shipped under the procedure of prior written notification and consent from 21 May 2026. As DIWASS will not be available to CAs and notifiers until this date, notifiers will need to obtain consent in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006 and specify a first departure date of 21 May 2026, if they wish to ship such material. Notifications should be submitted in advance of the 27 February 2026 deadline stated above due to the large number of notifications that will need to be processed by this office.

Transitional Provisions

Article 85 of Regulation (EU) 2024/1157 contains the relevant provisions associated with the transition from Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006. Article 85 (5) states:

“The recovery or disposal of waste in a shipment for which the competent authorities concerned have given their consent in accordance with Article 9 of Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006 shall be completed not later than one year from 21 May 2026”

This means that even though a notification consented to under Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006 may have a last departure date of 20 May 2027, all shipments on that notification will need to be recovered/disposed of by this date. The net result of this provision will be to reduce the effective length of the notification as both the shipment and recovery/disposal operation will need to take place by 21 May 2027.

Article 85 (6) states:

“Shipment for which the competent authorities concerned have given their consent in accordance with Article 14(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006 shall be completed not later than three years from 21 May 2026.”

This Article refers to notifications consented to under the pre-notification procedure. The recovery of waste on these notifications will need to be completed by 21 May 2029.
