# REGULATION (EU) 2024/1157

- Replaces Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006
- Most provisions apply from 21 May 2026
- Notifications consented under Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006 and green-list waste (GLW) shipments to non-OECD still recorded on WTMP
- Delay to implementation of GLW rules on DIWASS
- September 2025: [briefing note for exporters v2.pdf](#)
- November 2025: [briefing note 2 notification dates.pdf](#)
- Article 27: *Electronic submission and exchange of information*. Makes the use of Digital Waste Shipment System (DIWASS) mandatory for all shipments involving an EU country (including N. Ireland)

# DIGITAL WASTE SHIPMENT SYSTEM (DIWASS)



## Purpose and Implementation

- DIWASS aims to streamline and monitor all waste shipments in the EU, mandatory from May 2026
- Introduces digital authentication instead of physical signatures

## User Access and Interface

- Irish industry users will access DIWASS via the EC's portal (GUI), instead of WTMP

## Training and Transition

- Training and user manuals being provided, with some shipments continuing under older regulations until 2027

# DIGITAL WASTE SHIPMENT SYSTEM (DIWASS)



## Operator

- Notifier: TFS notifications
- Person Who Arranges Shipments: GLW
- Waste generator: TFS & GLW
- Carriers: TFS & GLW
- Waste treatment facility: TFS & GLW, imports only

## User

- The individual that represents an operator
- One user can represent multiple operators

# DIGITAL WASTE SHIPMENT SYSTEM (DIWASS)



## Notifier/Person Who Arranges Shipments

- Primary responsibility for completing and submitting waste shipment documents
- Authenticates Annex IA, IB and VII documents

## Waste generators

- Authenticates Annex IA and Annex VII

## Carriers

- Authenticates Annex IB and Annex VII

## Waste treatment facility (imports)

- Completes Annex IB and Annex VII

# GREEN-LIST WASTE SHIPMENTS ON DIWASS



- Original intention was that DIWASS was to apply for all green-list shipments from May 2026, except to non-OECD countries
- Delays with the implementation and testing
- This has now been postponed until the end of 2026; date TBC
- Continue to use WTMP during this period for reporting
- Further detail will be provided w/c 7 April

- April 21: DIWASS will open for registrations only
- Go-live: 21 May (for notifications only)
- During April: Final EC Instruction Manuals
