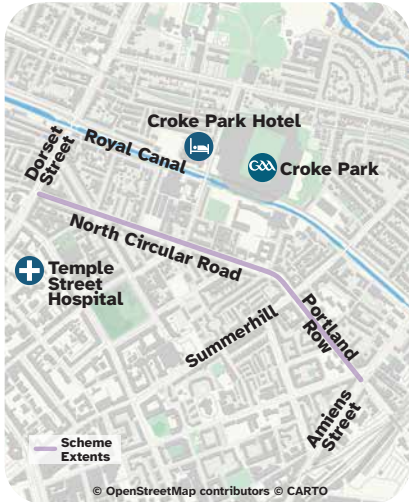

PROJECT OVERVIEW

This 1.1km scheme aims to deliver a safer, more accessible and sustainable transport corridor for all road users, with a focus on walking, wheeling and cycling.

Construction is expected to begin in August 2026. Works should take 18-20 months to complete. We will minimise disruption as much as possible.

Key Improvements

- High-quality, segregated cycle lanes in both directions
- Better pedestrian and cyclist crossings
- Upgrades to footpaths and carriageway surfaces
- Upgraded junctions at Belvidere Road, Fitzgibbon Street and Summerhill Parade
- ‘Continuous footpaths’ at minor side roads
- Six new bus stops to facilitate BusConnects’ proposed ‘O’ orbital route
- Improved public lighting, greening and landscaping measures

To enable these improvements, changes to on-street car parking and to permitted turns at some junctions will be necessary.
