Persons in charge of a horse at Smithfield Horse Fair must be 16 years of age or older.

Smithfield Horse Fair –GDPR

1. Dublin City Council is the data controller
2. The DPO's (Data Protection Officer) details are dataprotection@dublincity.ie and 01 2223775
3. The data subject's rights are:
 - The right to access the personal data that we hold about you, together with other information about our processing of the personal data.
 - The right to require us to rectify any inaccuracies in your personal data.
 - The right to require us to erase your personal data.
 - The right to request that we no longer process your personal data for particular purposes.
 - The right to object to our use of your personal data or the way we process it.
 - The right to receive your personal data, which you provided to us, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format or to require us to transmit that data to another controller.
4. Make a complaint to the DPC
 - If you are not satisfied with the outcome of the response you received from Dublin City Council in relation to your request, then you are entitled to make a complaint to the Data Protection Commission who may investigate the matter for you.

5. Reasons for requesting your personal information
 - This information is requested in order to issue a Casual Trading licence for the Smithfield Horse Fair.
 - The information is requested in accordance with the Casual Trading Act 1995, the Local Government Act 2001, the Smithfield Horse Control Bye-Laws 2013 and the Smithfield Horse Casual Trading Licence Fee Bye- Laws 2013.
 - It may be necessary from time to time to pass you contact information on to trusted third parties in order to assist with the processing of your application, such as our statutory partners, e.g. An Garda Síochána, as long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential.
 - The information supplied by you will be kept securely for a period of up to seven years.
 - If the personal data is not given a Casual Trading licence for the Smithfield Horse Fair cannot be issued as it is a requirement under the Casual Trading Act 1995, the Local Government Act 2001, the Smithfield Horse Control Bye-Laws 2013 and the Smithfield Horse Casual Trading Licence Fee Bye- Laws 2013
