As part of the **Annual Biodiversity Events Calendar**, Dublin City Council Parks and Landscape Services invites you to an evening of beautiful birdsong on the Banks Of the River Liffey. Join us on **May 30th** for a **free guided Dusk Chorus Walk** in Liffey Valley park with Eric "the Birdman" Dempsey from 7.30pm until 9.30pm starting from the Library in Ballyfermot. Eric is one of Ireland's leading bird experts, photographer of birds and a member of the presenting team on the popular **RTE Radio One *Mooney Goes Wild*** programme. He is also the author of a number of best selling books including the "Complete Guide To Ireland's Birds", "Finding Birds In Ireland" and "Birdwatching In Ireland".



Before the walk at 7pm you can join Niamh Ni Cholmain Dublin City Council Biodiversity Officer For Community Engagement to obtain information on where to see Biodiversity in the City during the summer and how to get involved in Citizen Science Volunteering.
