This plan has been prepared by Howley Hayes Architects for Dublin City Council's Culture, Recreation and Amenity Department, for the conservation and management of Herbert Park, Ballsbridge, Dublin 4. It examines the historical development of this fine municipal park; including its planting, buildings and features. An assessment of its cultural significance is included together with policies for its conservation and strategies for its enhancement. These are intended to provide guidance for the on-going maintenance and management of the Park to ensure that the significance of the landscape is preserved and presented clearly to the public. Dermot Foley Landscape Architects have provided an assessment of the historic and the current planting found in the park, along with suggestions about how this can be preserved and expanded. The measured, photographic and condition surveys of the structures were carried out between October 2014 and July 2015.
