

Ringsend Irishtown Local Environment Improvement Plan (LEIP)

Public Workshop at Ringsend Irishtown Community Centre, Wednesday, 7th December 2016

A second Public Workshop was held at Ringsend Irishtown Community Centre on Wednesday, 7th December 2016 at 7pm.

The following presentation was given by Marc Campbell of Mitchell and Associates who were appointed in March 2016 to oversee the compilation of the Local Environment Improvement Plan for Ringsend and Irishtown.

Discussion took place under five focus area headings as follows:

1. Library Plaza
2. Ringsend Park
3. Cambridge Road
4. York Road & Pigeon House Road
5. Improving Links
